# Presentation language

We encourage presentations in English, but also allow presentations in Finnish and Swedish. Please, choose your presentation language in the abstract submission form.

## **Presentation formats**

## Presentation 30 minutes including Q&A

The format is the more usual format and consists on one (two) speakers and allowing for questions and answers. This is a good format is if the participant needs updates on running issues or to receive new information. Interactive content is encouraged and presentations will most likely be paired with another presentation or a campfire discussion in one digital session of an hour.

Length of a standard presentation: 25 min + 5 min Q&A

## **Lightning Talks**

As the name suggests, lightning talks give speakers a limited amount of time to make their presentation – no more than 10 minutes. They may or may not include slides, but if they do, the slides usually move forward automatically to keep speakers to time. One chair will oversee the whole slot to keep the time.

Because lightning talks are brief, it requires the speaker to make their point clearly and rid the presentation of non-critical information. This, in turn, helps keep the attention of the audience. It also means many ideas can be presented in a short amount of time. In a period of 60 minutes we will have multiple lightning session and the programme committee will determine which sessions will be in the same slot. For this, please choose your keywords carefully.

Length of a standard presentation: 10 mins

## Campfire discussions

Campfire discussions begins with two speakers (up to 3) at the front of the room discussing freely about an idea, a solution or a problem. There is no moderator and the discussants introduce themselves to audience. After some time the focus may shift from the presenter to the audience if questions arise. Campfire discussions allow attendees to drive their own learning and share experiences with others, which also assists with networking.



These sessions will also be 30 minutes in length and possible paired with another normal oral presentation or another campfire discussion in a 1 hour digital slot.

Length of a standard presentation: 30 mins
